Here is a summary of the commands the Norton Editor provides:

**F1 Help**

**F2 Status**

**F3 File commands**

**E** *Exit*, save the data and end the edit session  
**Q** *Quit*, discard the data and end the edit session  
**S** *Save*, write the data to disk and continue editing  
**X** *eXchange* windows, switch to other window  
**N** *New*, edit a new file  
**A** *Append* another file to end of edit data  
**W** *Write* part of the data to disk  
**L** *Load* more data from a large file  
**C** *Close* the output file, open new output

**F4 Block commands**

**S** *Set* a block marker  
**R** *Remove* block markers  
**D** *Delete* a block  
**C** *Copy* a block  
**W** *Window-to-window* block copy  
**M** *Move* a block  
**L** *Line*, mark an entire line as a block  
**E** *End-of-line*, mark to end-of-line as a block  
**F** *Find* block marker

**F5 Screen format commands**

L	<i>Line length</i> , set line length
W	<i>Word-wrap</i> , toggle on and off
F	<i>Format</i> a paragraph
T	<i>Tab</i> , set tab spacing
I	<i>Indent</i> , toggle auto indent on and off
C	<i>Cursor</i> , set cursor type
D	<i>Display</i> , set display color
S	<i>Save editor</i> with new defaults set
K	<i>Key define</i> , change operation of Tab and Ins keys

**F6 Miscellaneous commands**

G	<i>Goto</i> a line number
M	<i>Matching</i> punctuation, finds matching symbol
C	<i>Condensed</i> display mode
Ins	<i>Insert</i> mode cancel, switch to <i>replace</i> mode
T	<i>Test</i> windows for differences

**F7 Printer commands**

P	<i>Print</i> entire edit buffer
B	<i>Block</i> , print marked block
E	<i>Eject</i> paper (form-feed)
S	<i>Size</i> in lines per page
M	<i>Margin</i> , set left margin for printing

**F9 DOS Command Processor****Other commands:**

F1	<i>Help</i> screens
F2	<i>Status</i> display
F9	<i>DOS</i> command processor
Ins	<i>Insert</i> , switch to insert mode
Ctrl-U	<i>Undelete</i>
Ctrl-F	<i>Find</i> or <i>find-and-replace</i>
Ctrl-C	<i>Continue</i> find operation
Ctrl-P	<i>Insert</i> control character
Ctrl-V	<i>Vice versa</i> , flip upper- and lowercase
