
Cursor Movement

Here is how the cursor is moved with the Norton Editor:

Right Arrow	right one character
Left Arrow	left one character
Up Arrow	up one line
Down Arrow	down one line
Ctrl-Right Arrow	right one word
Ctrl-Left Arrow	left one word
Home	beginning of line
End	end of line
PgUp	top of page <i>or</i> previous page
PgDn	bottom of page <i>or</i> next page
Ctrl-Home	beginning of the edit data
Ctrl-PgUp	beginning of the edit data
Ctrl-End	end of the edit data
Ctrl-PgDn	end of the edit data

The PgUp and PgDn keys act slightly differently, depending upon where the cursor is. Pressing PgUp moves the cursor to the top line of the screen if it isn't there already; if it is, PgUp jumps to the previous screen page of the file.
